This large, colorful kit was created in collaboration with teachers and students from all across Mexico who donated many of the cultural items and designed the teaching plans. Covers a broad range of regional cultures in Mexico, from pre-Colombian to modern-day.

Highlights: Many folk art items. Models of pre-Colombian Olmec & Aztec statues, traditional household items such as a tortilla basket & *Molinillo* chocolate whisk, pop-culture Barbie doll from the international hit Mexican soap opera “*Rebelde*”, items from traditional celebrations such as a Day of the Dead Sugar Skull, a model Quetzal Dancer and a *Jarocho* dance dress. The included CMLC produced “Singing Home” CD showcases several traditional Mexican songs by local Linn/Benton residents of Mexican descent.
