Biggest to Smallest (Seriation) Culture Exploration Kit

Around the world, people have devised ways to create objects that hold smaller and smaller objects inside. This kit provides a look at several of these nesting items such as Russian Matryosha dolls, Tutsi nesting baskets and silk lined Chinese boxes. These items are ideal for exploring math concepts such as biggest to smallest or comparing volumes; creating story problems involving a matching up of the different sizes or a geography lesson of where the items were created.
