



The Cultures of Afghanistan

In response to educator requests we are now offering a compact kit highlighting the multicultural nature of Afghanistan.

Kit Highlights: a Burqa (with pro and con commentary by Afghan women), tribal *kutchi* dresses, antique hand-washing pitcher (the traditional wedding gift from fathers to daughters), a whip from the national polo-like sport *Buzkashi*, currency, and a mini-display on the history of the carrot, which originated in Afghanistan.

Also included: “Singing Home”, a CMLC produced CD with 2 Afghan songs sung by a local Afghan immigrant, and “Skatistan”, a book on a contemporary skateboard charity project in Afghanistan that includes both boys and girls.
