Currently, thousands of refugees are fleeing each day to our sister city, Uzhhorod, located in the most western region of Ukraine. The citizens of Uzhhorod are mobilizing to provide comfort, support, and humanitarian aid to those who have had to flee the violence.

Ways to Help:

- 1. Citizens Banks: Checks and cash can be dropped off at any Citizens Bank Branches in the Willamette Valley.
- 2. Donate to the GoFundMe Account.
- 3. Order a post: Local artist, Earl Newman, is donating 100% of the proceeds from a silk-screened art print (shown here) titled, WITH PEOPLE...UKRAINE, which he created for the Uzhhorod Refugee Fund to help those displaced by the violence.

At CMLC we love spring and even more so to see you in our classes.




All materials for art classes are included. Masks are welcome but not required.

She spends most of her time with her husband and daughter. Together they like to explore the beauty of Oregon. She also likes to learn about how our ancestors built the world we live in today.




Naomi Halpern Development and Program Coordinator


